Together, We Protect Children

Children must be protected from all forms of abuse, neglect, exploitation, and any other forms of violence against them.



It is our shared responsibility to ensure their protection.

ZERO-Tolerance For Sexual Exploitation and Abuse (SEA)

At EMPHNET, we strictly enforce a ZERO-TOLERANCE policy for SEA.

It is strictly prohibited to engage in any SEA activities in exchange for money, employment, preferential treatment, goods, or any kind of services.

Strictly Prohibited

It is strictly prohibited to engage in any SEA activities with anyone under the age of 18 years. Mistaken belief as to the age of the person is not an excuse.


No Excuse
